ASSIMILATE: I will continue to mentor my family and friends until they are firmly grounded in the faith and/or assimilated into the active life of the Church.

Knowing that faith is a gift we are given by God, I will trust the ministry of the Holy Spirit to guide my actions and inspire my words, to the end that Jesus Christ will be given all glory and honor.
